Therefore do not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which you have heard me speak in those days; for John baptized you with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now. Therefore let us go on to Jerusalem, that we may witness the fulfillment of what the Lord has said by the mouth of his prophets, that the Messiah is to suffer and to rise from the dead on the third day, and that repentance and forgiveness of sins shall be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. See, I am sending you what I have promised; and you shall remain in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high. But he led them out as far as Bethany, and, lifting up his hands, he blessed them. While he was blessing them, he withdrew and ascended into heaven. 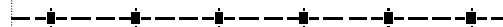
